

# Ice Breakers

## Ideas

### **BEACH BALL (SMALL TO MID-SIZE GROUP)**

Note: You can play with a large group but you may need two beach balls and break up into two groups. Purchase a beach ball or if you already have one SCORE! Write out a list of "getting to know you" type of questions like:

- What would be the most amazing adventure to go on?
- What game or movie world would you most like to live in?
- What's your favorite genre of book or movie?

Grab a sharpie and write on a beach ball all the questions you have come up with. Ask the team member to get into a circle and toss the ball to someone. When that person catches the ball, ask them to read the question closest to their left thumb aloud and answer it — once they are done, they pass it to another person.

### **FIND 10 THINGS IN COMMON: (SMALL OR LARGE GROUP)**

Break up into groups of 5 or so Each group must find ten things that they have in common with each other.

Important Rule\* No cop-outs such as body parts are not allowed. "Ohhh...look we all have arms!! What are the chances of that!"

### **M&M ICE BREAKER (SMALL OR LARGE GROUP)**

Break up the group into smaller groups Grab a bag of M&M's and pass out a single M&M to each person. Whatever color the person gets means that they have to answer a specific question about themselves. Such as blue M&M have to share the most exciting thing that happen this week. While red M&M have to share a goal or passion they are actively pursuing.

Note: get creative get your chapter to talk about their personal passions.

The best part of this game is well...everyone gets to eat chocolate! SCORE!
